



HONEY BROOK ORGANIC FARM'S SWITCHING DAYS POLICY

Honey Brook Organic Farm's week runs from Monday to Sunday.

If you need to switch your day, please follow these guidelines:

You must call (609-737-8899) or e-mail (susan@honeybrookorganicfarm.com) your change request at least 24 hours in advance.

To pick up your farm share, excluding pick-your-own crops, you may switch to any day WITHIN the week, except for Sunday. For example, if you have a Friday pick-up, you may come to the farm stand the previous Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or the Saturday immediately following your regularly scheduled Friday. Please check your name off in the sign-in binder behind the tab after your regularly scheduled day. You must still wear your Membership Card, even though you won't be here on your normal pick-up day.

Members may not switch their pick-up day to Sunday. Only members assigned Sunday as their regularly scheduled day may pick up produce in the stand.

Your membership privileges may be exercised only once per week and are not transferable to a future week. For example, if you do not pick up your share this week, you may not pick up a "double share" next week.

Pick-Your-Own Crops – You may come to the farm any day of the week, Monday through Sunday during regular farm hours. Remember that your membership privileges may be exercised only once per week and are not transferable to a future week. For example, if you do not pick your share of raspberries this week, you may not pick a double portion next week. You must wear your Membership Card to enter the p-y-o fields even if it is not your regular pick-up day.

If you are going on vacation or cannot pick up for some other reason, you may ask a friend, neighbor or family member to pick up the produce in your place. Our staff will be happy to show newcomers the ropes, but consider bringing your friends out to the farm in advance to show them what to do. Also, the Members' Handbook is available on-line and should provide a thorough introduction to someone new to the farm.
